

Do you know the difference between the runningsports ‘A Club For All’ and sports coach UK ‘Equity In Your Coaching’ Workshop?

runningsports constantly review feedback from all workshops and we have noticed that some clubs (specifically those going through Clubmark) have noted that there are similarities between the runningsports ‘A Club For All’ workshop and the sports coach UK ‘Equity In Your Coaching’ workshop.

Therefore please see the guidance below to aid understanding of the differences between the two workshops to assist you (the workshop organiser) with the marketing of the information to potential attendees.

These workshops have been produced for two different audiences:

- **A Club For All** is designed to be attended by volunteers in a club, (possibly a club member, member of the committee or the volunteer co-ordinator). The tutor will use club management and administration examples to help the volunteer/club member understand the benefits of opening up their club to the wider community and being equitable in their membership and club practices. The workshop will assist them in producing a basic action plan for their club, with a view to its future sustainability.
- **Equity In Your Coaching** is designed to be attended by a sports coach. The tutor will use coaching examples to help coaches understand how they, as a coach in their coaching practice, should be equitable in their language and actions towards different people. Coaches have an important role to play in ensuring this happens therefore the workshop will help them to apply and extend their existing skills, meet the needs of present and potential participants and find out where to go for further information.

NB:

It’s really important that the same person doesn’t attend both workshops as materials covered in the introduction, (outlining what sports equity is and why it’s so important) are very similar.
